

Major Wood Bouldin (1742 – 1800) was a prominent Virginia attorney and farmer. He was a veteran of the Revolutionary War.

When Major Wood Bouldin was born on 4 June 1742, in Maryland, British Colonial America, his father, Thomas Bouldin, was 36 and his mother, Nancy Ann Clark, was 27. He married Joanna Tyler on 2 April 1777, in Charlotte, Virginia, British Colonial America. They were the parents of at least 4 sons and 6 daughters. He died on 13 March 1800, in Charlotte, Virginia, United States, at the age of 57, and was buried in Golden Hills Estate Cemetery, Drakes Branch, Charlotte, Virginia, United States.
